How to fill in and submit an ORF

Most atlassers are having problems dealing with the ORF email that arrives from ADU – it is actually quite simple. You don't need to print it, fill it in by pen, scan and attach it!

The RAC committees, be they here or in other countries, need your original email and the ORF PDF that is attached to your email. Here is an example of what you will see for each ORF on your card...

However, all you need do is click the **Forward** button on your email, which opens your reply – *don't use Reply or Reply all.*

This method attaches the PDF to your reply, probably with the cursor conveniently on **To...** For Zimbabwe you use <u>raczimsabap2@gmail.com</u> which you can type in or copy from the sheet, *but use the address shown if your card pertains to another country.*

You will now find the Verification sheet has become active! Fill in all the details you have, especially the ID section and the one below on why you were able to exclude similar species. Include as much detail as you can recall or noted down at the time of the sighting.

All you need do now is click the **Send** button.

Do open the PDF on the original mail – it shows you your pentad in the crosshairs and SABAP1 data for the bird on a map, and other accepted pentad records from SABAP2.

Your ORF may be **Full Out of Range**, **Marginal** or **Seasonal** – the latter for migrants.
